

# SAN ANTONIO WORK CAMP STUDENT REGISTRATION

June 13-16, 2010

Registration Deadline: May 2, 2010

Work Camp 2010 will open on Sunday evening, June 13th, at 6:00 p.m. at the MacArthur Park Church of Christ building. Eat dinner before you arrive. Team meetings and a devotional time will kick-off our Work Camp. Sunday night we will organize our work crews. We will discuss the camp rules and safety regulations and explain the work assignments in more detail.

Monday-Wednesday we will meet early morning for prayer and then proceed to our work sites in neighborhoods around San Antonio. We will be painting the exteriors of several homes. All driving to and from work sites will be done by adults. Teens are not allowed to drive to sites.

We will eat lunch together and continue working throughout the afternoon. Each evening we will meet together for a time of devotion and sharing of the day's experiences.

## **Bring A Sack Lunch**

Students will be asked to bring a sack lunch for each workday. Drinks on the job site will be provided.

## **Bring A Change Of Clothes**

After leaving the sites each day, work crews will have the opportunity for fellowship and relaxation. Bring modest swimwear. Please bring an appropriate change of clothes for evening activities.

## **Camp Schedule**

A full camp schedule will be provided after registration. Students are expected to participate in daily work and evening devotionals. Early dismissal for a day must be pre-approved by the directing team.

## **Work Sites**

All work sites will be located in the city of San Antonio. Each work site will be inspected prior to camp and assessed for needed work and safety precautions. If the site looks too dangerous, it will not be accepted.

The majority of work will be painting older, small wood-frame homes. Other work may include yard cleaning, grass and weed cutting, and raking. All work will be done outside the house. Students are not allowed to work inside the homes.

## **Work Teams**

Each work team will consist of 12-20 students and at least three adults. Students should dress in modest clothing and wear sun block. Students may not bring MP3 players/CD players to the work sites. Teams will be assigned by the youth ministers and may not be changed.

## **Registration**

Students who have completed the 6-12th grades in the 2009-2010 school year are eligible to attend. Younger students are not allowed on the job sites.

Cost of registration is \$50 per student. There are limited spaces for Work Camp 2010 and we anticipate filling all the spots before the deadline. Sign up early!

Registration deadline is May 2, 2010.
